Seminar: Mr. Lawrence DeAngelo: "Training and Business Development Programs in China" and more presentations

This is the October's OCEAN Monthly Meeting. Dr. Jingxuan Kang, Chair of Entrepreneurship Club and vice president of OCEAN hold this meeting. Three speakers gave all nice presentations about new business opportunities, cooperation and developments.

1. Mr. Xiaofeng Mu, an overseas scholar in USA 10 years ago and a writer in China now. He come to USA this time to make 20 serie s films and a 90 minutes movie for 20 students at Harvard and MIT who were educated till middle school in China. He is working for the New Film Making Center of China Center TV Station. His movie making team will come to Boston later. He joined this meeting and gave a short talk to share his experience to work in China for these years, and also discussed the possible opportunities for cooperation with OCEAN to promote overseas Chinese scholars and entrepreneurs in their entrepreneurship life.
2. Mr. Zengmiao Hu, a professor in life science and an office director working for Hongkong, Aomen and Taiwen at Qingdao Ocean University, came to Boston to seek the opportunity to work with OCEAN mainly for international training programs. He gave a short talk to introduce Qingdao University and discussed the cooperation with OCEAN.
3. Mr. Lawrence DeAngelo, President of Business International, gave a presentation on "Training and Business Development Programs in China".
