Seminar "Patent Issues, Venture Capitals, Company Benefit Plans, and Drug Application Procedures in China and USA"

OCEAN, jointly with MIT CSSA presented a seminar on "Patent Issues, Venture Capitals, Company Benefit Plans, and Drug Application Procedures in China and USA". The Seminar was at MIT in Building 1, Room 190 on Saturday, May 27, 1:00pm - 5:30pm. This Seminar focused on practical issues an entrepreneur often faces in starting and operating a technology-intensive business. The invited speakers discussed practical issues in their respective field of expertise and answered general questions from the audience.

Speakers: Dr. Li-Ming Shen who was from the Food and Drug Administration in Washington D.C. with extensive experience in new drug application regulations and procedures. Dr. Quanli Yang of Harvard Medical School had in-depth experience in the pharmaceutical industry and invented five drugs that are marketed in China. Dr. Zhuang Su, who recently applied for a new drug in China, discussed issues on seeking new drug approval in China. Dr. Y. Phil Zhang, who introduced U.S. patent law, patent procedures and invention protection, is a patent attorney at a large Boston law firm with more than 300 attorneys. Dr. Weixing Huang has had twenty years business law working experience since he got his law Ph.D. from Harvard Law School. Mr. Kaibin Wu, who had been working in the area of small business benefit plan for many years, presented issues regarding small business operations and benefit plans for small businesses.
